Language requirement: fluency in English and basic German or willingness to acquire basic German within one year (B1)

**Your duties:** you will occupy the central position for empirical data collection and analysis within this major project. Over three years, you will coordinate the collection of individual-level data in an international CATI-assisted or online panel survey, online and offline experiments and local field experiments with political actors. You will manage one research assistant with a Master's degree and several others with lower degrees. You will contribute to theory development and will be responsible for quantitative analyses of the data collected. With the project team and independently, you will share the results within the academic community through publications. You will assume various administrative tasks in the team with English as the working language.

More specifically, your responsibilities will include co-design and management of data collection, communicating with partners and service providers, undertaking empirical analyses in applied statistics, writing scientific publications, organising workshops, participating in international conferences and further training relevant to the project, and the administration and production of reports for the ERC.

#### **Required qualifications**

- Masters degree or equivalent in one of the behavioural or social sciences (e.g. Political Science, Sociology) with excellent final marks
- Completed PhD in an area of direct relevance for the project, such as survey research, political sociology, political psychology, or welfare state research, completed submission upon application
- Experience with the empirical analysis of individual-level survey data
- Skills in advanced applied statistics
- Willingness to further train in the areas of statistics, survey analysis, experimental design and programming
- Strong communication skills in written and spoken English

- Some command of German (B1) or willingness to acquire within one year

- Experience with the analysis and/or data collection of comparative survey data (questionnaire design, measurement quality, data management)
- Experience with field experimental designs
- Experience abroad of 6 months or more
